troduction	This policy focuses on the participation of children and young people in the life of our St Seraphim ROCOR and on making the St Seraphim ROCOR a safe environment for them.
	It supplements the Policy and Procedure for Addressing Inappropriate Behavior and the Child-Safe, Child-Friendly Policy of the Australian and New Zealand Diocese of the Russian Orthodox Church outside Russia and provides guidance to St Seraphim ROCOR clergy, officials, volunteers, members and all involved in St Seraphim ROCOR life.
Definitions	For the purposes of this policy, 'children' are aged 0-12, and 'young people' are aged 13-18.
Definitions	<i>Child-safe</i> means taking active measures to keep children and young people safe from physical, sexual or emotional abuse.
	Child-friendly means creating a trusting environment that values, respects and welcomes children and young people. This means children and young people feel confident to raise any problem or concern and know they will be listened to. Experience shows that abuse most often occurs when children lack that confidence and trust.
	All references to the 'parish' and 'parish life' are to St Seraphim ROCOR and its activities. References to 'the Diocese' and to 'Diocesan policy' are to the Australian and New Zealand Diocese of the Russian Orthodox Church outside Russia and its policies.
